Medical Disclaimer Policy (Draft) 2026

1. Purpose

FOXG1 UK provides information and peer support for individuals and families affected by FOXG1 syndrome and related conditions.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that any medical or health-related information shared by the charity is clearly understood to be informational only and not a substitute for professional medical advice. This policy helps protect beneficiaries, volunteers, and trustees by clarifying the limits of the charity's role.

2. No Medical Advice

FOXG1 UK does not provide medical diagnosis, treatment, or clinical advice.

Information shared through the charity's website, publications, social media, support groups, or events is intended for general informational and educational purposes only.

Individuals should always seek advice from a qualified healthcare professional regarding medical concerns, diagnosis, or treatment decisions.

3. Consultation with Healthcare Professionals

Families and individuals are strongly encouraged to consult appropriate healthcare professionals, including:

- General practitioners (GPs)
- Paediatricians
- Neurologists
- Genetic specialists
- Other qualified medical professionals involved in their care

4. Peer Support and Shared Experiences

- Moderators will remind participants that peer support discussions do not constitute medical advice.

5. Online Communities and Social Media

Within these communities:

- Members must not present personal opinions as medical advice.
- Moderators may remove posts that promote unsafe, unverified, or harmful medical claims.
- The charity cannot guarantee the accuracy of information posted by third parties.
- Members should verify medical information with healthcare professionals before acting on it.
